Discover the natural beauty of Wisconsin as you have lunch at the World-renowned Boerner Botanical Gardens and tour through the paradise of roses. After the 1½ hour tour in the flowers and shrubs landscape, a tour guide will step onto our bus and guide us through the historical green built city of Greendale, WI.
